SUBJECT Recommendation from the Energy and Green Advisory Board

On Friday, July 8, 2016, the Energy and Green Advisory Board voted to recognize the *Prescriptive Tradeoff Code Compliance Option for the NCTCOG Region* as published by the Energy Systems Laboratory (ESL).

Additionally, the Energy and Green Advisory Board has approved two forms: *Residential Buildings Compliance Path* and the *Residential Buildings Compliance Certificate*. The first to be submitted with a permit application and the second to be submitted at completion of a project. The forms are provided for use as templates by cities in the NCTCOG regions.

The Energy and Green Advisory Board forwards all three documents to the RCCC with a recommendation that the RCCC forward these forms to the City Managers and Building Officials in the NCTCOG region.
