Task 3: WQMP Coordination and Update

- Suggestions for new data or priorities to incorporate into the plan
 - Reuse permits
 - TPDES permitted discharge by segment
 - Combine population projections, water quality impairments, high TPDES permit density to produce priority areas
- Update service area boundaries for wastewater – work with wastewater service providers to get most up to date GIS information
- List of new WWTPs coming in and any WWTPs retiring during FY2017
- Data on treated effluent (gallons) from each wastewater service provider
- Engage rural wastewater service providers
