We have determined that the Dallas-Fort Worth Metropolitan Area Mobility 2025 Transportation Plan (MTP) and FY 2000-2002 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), meet all requirements for making a joint conformity determination under the Clean Air Act Amendments of 1990. The MTP and TIP conformity determination and the procedures used to make this determination are in accordance with the provisions of the transportation conformity rule dated August 15, 1997 (40 CFR Parts 51 and 93), as amended.

The Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) acts as executive agent for the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) on Plan and TIP air quality conformity determinations. Accordingly, this letter will serve as the joint FHWA/FTA conformity determination.
